Purpose: The purpose of this position is to manage all shop related activity for the Live Media division including maintenance/repairs, assist with inventory management, integration/upgrades of mobile unit facilities to operation to Live Media Group standards and ultimately fulfill client requests.

Position Responsibilities:

- Contribute to the organization by effectively managing the Field Shop and facilitating an efficient working environment for Field Shop and support personnel.
- Review event post-reports after events, flag any engineering concerns to Chief Engineers and coordinate equipment repair, etc. working with VP and Chief Engineers.
- Manage the scheduling of maintenance of mobile units, integrations and upgrades at the field shop working with the VP of Engineering, Director of Fleet Operations and Chief Engineers
- Work with VP and assist with implementation of Maintenance Tracking system and managing once completed to improve our shops efficiency.
- Repair and maintain various computer and networking equipment used in broadcasting operations.
- Coordinates and assists with equipment installations and faxing of mobile units.
- Coordinates and assists with the maintenance and repair of assets and mobile units.
- Coordinates and assists with upgrades and integration of new mobile units helping to develop, implement and effectively complete upgrades and integrations on time and within budgets.
- Provide technical assistance, training, and leadership to Mobile Unit Engineers when needed.
- Document faults and problems with equipment and make proper orders so that repairs can be made.
- Maintain a low turnaround on equipment repairs and a high degree of accuracy in testing, calibration, and repairs.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Technical or bachelor's degree in the engineering field; however, a combination of education and experience will be considered.
- Requires 5 years of industry related experience as a repair/maintenance technician or engineer.
- Demonstrated knowledge of broadcast management, technology, equipment, facilities, and production for major commercial and cable television networks.
- Up-to-date knowledge of latest proprietary broadcasting equipment, hardware, and software.
- Must be able to effectively supervise and direct technical personnel.
- Attention to detail, ability to meet tight deadlines and work on multiple projects simultaneously.
- Demonstrate excellent quality control when repairing and maintaining equipment.
- Must be willing and able to travel travel may be needed at various times depending on project schedules.
- Must be willing and able to lift/push/pull up to 50 lbs. and be willing to seek assistance for anything over 50 lbs.(should not seek to do over 50 lbs. without assistance).
- Should reside in/around Columbus, OH area.
